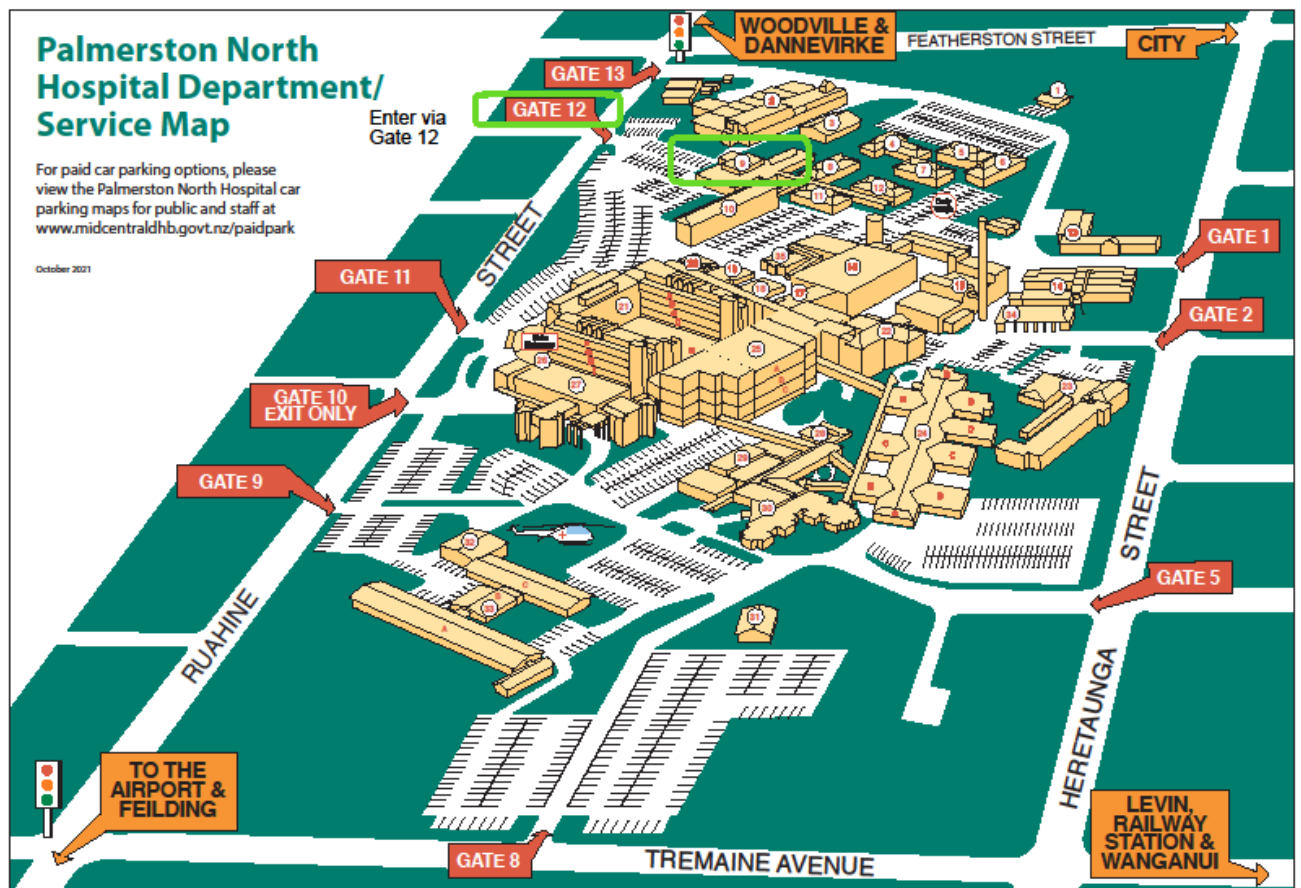

### Venue instructions

Enter Palmerston North Hospital Campus via **Gate 12** (off Ruahine Street)
